



### "Battle OF Maine"

The Sukee Arena in Winslow, Maine, was the site for the 21st "BATTLE OF MAINE". Over 600 competitors and 1,335 spectators from all over New England and Canada attended. The "BATTLE OF MAINE", one of Maine's largest and oldest Martial Arts Events certainly lived up to expectations again. The Promoter's Randy, Mike, and Mark Huard go to great lengths to provide a FUN, SAFE, & FAIR, MARTIAL ARTS EVENT. The "BATTLE OF MAINE" was an "A" rated event with the MAINE S.M.A.R.T. rating service and was also sanctioned by I.P.P.O.N.E.

The "BATTLE OF MAINE" featured Kata, Weapons, Kumite, Musical Kata/Weapons, Self Defense, and Physically Challenged divisions. Beautiful trophies and medals were awarded to the top 8 Weapons and Kata competitors and many Grand Champions were crowned. This year's "BATTLE OF MAINE" brought in some superrr talent from Canada, Mexico, and other parts of New England. Studios Unis of Quebec Canada sent down an impressive competition team featuring some outstanding competitors.

The Tournament started off with a demonstration of SYNCHRONIZED TEAM FORMS. S.M.A.R.T. STATE CHAMPIONS Drew Rountree and Reggie Levesque of "TEAM TAO" entertained the large crowd with a wonderful Synchronized Musical Kata routine. The Black Belt Musical Kata/Weapons divisions were next, starting with the 17 & Under Jr. Black Belts. This was a very competitive division with several of New England's best Jr. Black Belts going all out for the win. All were outstanding, but there could only be one winner, "TEAM TAO's Reggie Levesque edged out CLUB NAHA's Javier Diaz, Jr. by a mere .2 tenths of a point.

The Adult Black Belt Musical division was also very large and competitive, but when the smoke cleared, Legendary New England competitor Bobby "Tokyo Joe" Lamattina of Nashua, NH, squeaked by local favorite Shane Galfagher of Huard's Ju Jitsu Karate. In the huge Jr. Colored Belt Musical Kata/Weapons division, it came down to Tommy Paquet of STUDIOS UNIS and Meagan Forsythe of Huard's Ju Jitsu Karate. Both dazzled the audience with their expertise; but in the end, Tommy pulled through with the win by another slight .2 tenths of a point. Following the Musical divisions came the Kata, Kumite, Weapons, and Self Defense divisions. The competitors were focused and ready for any and all challenges to come.



The MAINE MARTIAL ARTS CHALLENGE, Maine's oldest running tournament was held at a NEW location this year, the Maranacook High School in Readfield, Maine. Maranacook H.S. is set in the beautiful countryside overlooking Maranacook Lake and is just a short 10-minute drive from Maine's capital city of Augusta. The MAINE MARTIAL ARTS CHALLENGE has had a rich history of attracting some of the best talent from not only New England, Canada, and Mexico but from all over the USA. Martial Arts Legends such as Billy Blanks, Richard Brandon, and Chuck Merriman competed in the past at the MAINE MARTIAL ARTS CHALLENGE/TAO OPEN.


