November 13, 1999, kicked off the 1st Annual Elm City Kids Karate Challenge at the Harold & Bibby Alford Youth Recreation Center in Waterville, Maine. Congratulations to Club Naha's Sensei Ken Walsh and Tao Karate Club's Sensei Jeff Wood for an outstanding tournament. This was the debut tournament for the new S.M.A.R.T. Rating System. S.M.A.R.T., which stands for STATE MARTIAL ARTS RATINGS & TOTALS, is an organization representing Maine martial artists and promoters. WHO ARE MAINE'S BEST MARTIAL ARTISTS? We'll soon find out!

For a 1st year tournament, the Elm City Kids Karate Challenge turned out to be an amazing event. This tournament featured 110 Divisions and SIX GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS including FOUR under Black Belt GRANDS. The new \$7 million facility is incredible, every aspect of the tournament was organized, the judging was fair, & the trophies were beautiful. Over eighty competitors participated in the triple gymnasium, and several hundred spectators observed the action. With the exception of a Black Belt meeting running into the starting time, the tournament was near perfect.

The Musical Forms Division started the show and it proved to be the most energizing event of the tournament. It's a shame that just a few promoters have Musical divisions at their tournaments. The audience and competitors love watching the Musical Katas and more competitors would compete in that division if it were made available in other tournaments. In the Musical 12 & under Novice Division, 1st place went to DEREK CARTER. In the Musical 12 & under Intermediate/Advanced Division, 1st place went to TIFFANY JOHNSON. TERRELL KOCZYNSKI walked away with 1st place for the Musical 13 - 17 Intermediate/Advanced Division. And the Black Belt Musical 17 & under 1st place winner was REGGIE LEVESQUE. Reggie, who is a Red Belt and a student of Sensei Wood, was bumped up to the Musical Black Belt Division. Reggie brought the house down with his entertaining, new musical routine.

The Self Defense and Weapons divisions were next. They are always a lot of fun to watch. Forms and point fighting followed. The competitors in the Forms Division were very good, and the Point Sparring was very competitive. Here is an idea for next year's tournament—How about Continuous Fighting & Synchronized Forms for the Advanced and Black Belt Divisions?

As a father of a martial artist and a veteran of 65 karate tournaments, both regionally and nationally, I enjoyed this tournament as much as any I have attended. I give it a TWO THUMBS UP!

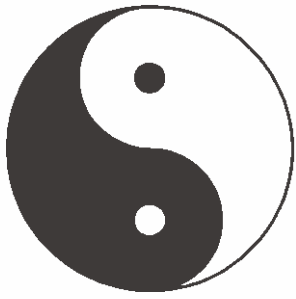

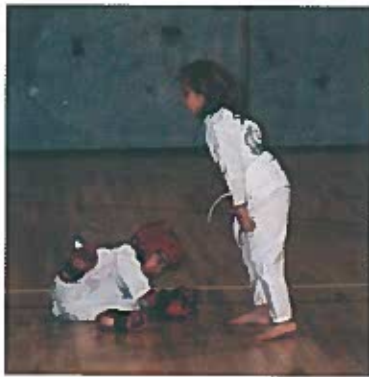
